## A Northern Arizona Bird Sanctuary

The Northern Arizona Bird Sanctuary program recognizes places that provide regionally important bird habitat and exceptional birding opportunities. This designation is intended to increase public interest in birds and awareness of the natural values of these special places.

### Key

**C** Common – expected to be present

**F** Fairly common – often present

**U** Uncommon – occurs regularly, but often absent

**R** Rare – occurs infrequently

**I** Irregular – not predictable in occurrence

**X** Accidental – very few records, out of range or habitat

**p** permanent resident

**s** summer resident

**w** winter resident

**m** migrant
